Basic Provisions

III. Legal Basis and Purpose of Data Processing

The legal basis for processing personal data is the performance of a contract or other obligation and the provision of services between you and the controller. The purpose of processing personal data is to handle your contact form, send commercial communications, and marketing offers.

IV. Data Retention Period

The controller stores personal data for the period necessary to fulfill the rights and obligations arising from the contractual relationship between you and the controller and to exercise claims from these contractual relationships (for 5 years from the termination of the contractual relationship). After the retention period, the controller will delete the personal data.

V. Recipients of Personal Data (Subcontractors of the Controller)

The recipients of personal data are entities that provide services for the operation of websites, marketing, and hosting.

The controller intends to transfer personal data to third countries (outside the EU) or international organizations. The recipients of personal data in third countries are service providers in tourism, Caria Pan Travel Turkey.

VI. Your Rights

As the data subject, you have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Correct or delete your personal data, or restrict its processing
- Request information about the personal data being processed
- Obtain clarification regarding the processing of personal data
- Object to processing
- Data portability (i.e., the right to receive personal data concerning you that you provided to the controller in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, as per Article 20 of the GDPR)

• Withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal, if processing is based on Article 6(1)(a) or Article 9(2)(a) of the GDPR.

VII. Conditions for Securing Personal Data

The controller declares that appropriate technical and organizational measures have been taken to secure personal data.

Technical measures to secure data storage and personal data in digital form include antivirus and firewalls. The controller declares that personal data is only accessible to authorized, verifiably trained individuals. The controller affirms that no automated decision-making, including profiling, as defined in Article 22, paragraphs 1 and 4 of the GDPR, takes place during the processing. The controller further declares that personal data will be processed automatically through computers and computer programs.

VIII. Final Provisions
